Open Participation for Creative Exchange

The workshops are conducted in a unique way — four moderators share specific topics in different spaces at the same time. Participants can choose to attend workshops on different topics according to their interests. This allows immediate interaction with moderators, as well as attending more than one workshop within a given period of time.

(1) Latest Development of Performing Arts Spaces

As times change, performing arts spaces face unprecedented challenges and opportunities. The limitations of traditional theatre spaces, the rise of new performance forms and the evolving needs of audiences have all presented new demands on the design, management, and operation of performing arts spaces.

(2) Promotional Collaboration and Social Media

In an era of information overload, how to effectively promote performing arts events and attract more audiences has become a major challenge for arts groups and organisations. This workshop will delve into the crucial role of promotional collaboration and social media in promoting performing arts by sharing practical experience to help participants master promotional strategies in the age of new media.

文化導賞團: 保育、活化與社區創新

City Walks: Conservation, Revitalisation and Community Innovation

文化導賞團將會探索荃灣、深水埗、中上環和土瓜灣四個社區,透過不同焦點考察香港對於保育、活化與社區創新的文化策略。活動行程由本地文化企業「活現香港」設計及導賞。

The city walks will explore four communities: Tsuen Wan, Sham Shui Po, Central and Sheung Wan, and To Kwa Wan, examining Hong Kong's cultural strategies for conservation, revitalisation and community innovation from different perspectives. The itineraries are designed and guided by the local cultural enterprise Walk in Hong Kong.

荃灣 Tsuen Wan

這個行程將探索荃灣的歷史文化遺產,感受保育與活化藝術的魅力。首先參觀南豐紗廠,欣賞舊廠房的現代化改造,回顧香港紡織工業輝煌的發展歷程。接著前往三棟屋,探索客家圍村的建築風格和生活方式。然後造訪石碧新村,參觀香港少數分佈於大廈中的「城中村」,再到賽馬會德華公園欣賞中國傳統園林的設計。最後前往如心園,參觀香港唯一的木化石公園,探索地質學與自然歷史的奧秘。此行程讓大家體驗濃厚歷史與文化氣息的荃灣。



To experience the charm of conservation and revitalisation of historical and cultural heritage in Tsuen Wan, we will pay a visit to The Mills to uncover the modernisation process of an old factory and the rich history of Hong Kong's once-important textile industry. We will then explore the traditional architectural style of and way of life in Sam Tung Uk Village, a Hakka walled village. Next, we will visit Shek Pik San Tsuen, one of the few urban villages in Hong Kong, followed by a stroll in the Jockey Club Tak Wah Park featuring the design of a traditional Chinese garden. Our final stop is Nina Park, the only petrified wood park in Hong Kong, where we learn about its geology and natural history. Experience Hong Kong's diverse culture and history in Tsuen Wan.





深水埗 Sham Shui Po

這個行程將會探索深水埗的創意與文化,感受舊區的活化與發展。起步於賽馬會創意藝術中心,了解這幢由舊工廠大廈活化而成的垂直藝術村兼藝術中心,沿白田街步行到由第一型「H型」徙置大廈活化而成的美荷樓青年旅舍,參觀舍內生活館,回望香港早期公共房屋的生活樣貌。之後,到訪公和荳品廠,了解古法石磨豆製品的製作過程,接著漫步鴨寮街和大南街,探索特色小店,感受藝術與創意、情懷與創新交織於多元魅力的深水埗。

In this route, we will explore the creativity and culture of Sham Shui Po, an old district where revitalisation and development are in progress. The tour starts at Jockey Club Creative Arts Centre where the old factory building is revitalised and transformed into an vertical arts hub. Then, we will go to Mei Ho House and experience the way of life in Hong Kong's earliest public housing estate. Next, we will visit the Kung Wo Beancurd Factory, getting to know the traditional stone mill process of making bean products. Afterward, we will stroll through Apliu Street and Tai Nan Street to explore specialty stores and enjoy the artistic and creative expressions woven into the diverse neighbourhood in Sham Shui Po.





中上環 Central and Sheung Wan

這個行程將會探索中環和上環的歷史、文化與藝術景點。起步於具八十年歷史的中環街市,欣賞經過活化的現代街市,然後在中環乘搭全世界最長的戶外扶手電梯通往半山,將香港獨特的城市景觀盡收眼底。接下來造訪大館,了解前中區警署建築群的前世今生與中西合璧的建築特色,然後慢步荷里活道,欣賞沿途歷史建築與特色店舖。接著前往 PMQ 元創方,感受創意產業的蓬勃發展。最終參觀「卅間」活化唐樓及太平山街的壁畫,體驗香港的藝術活力。

This itinerary will take you on a journey to explore the historical, cultural and artistic landmarks in Central and Sheung Wan. The tour begins at the Central Market where the 80-year-old historic building has been revitalised and modernised. Riding the Central-Mid-Levels Escalators, the world's longest outdoor covered escalator system, we arrive at Tai Kwun to get in touch with the history and the unique east-meets-west architectural features of the former Central Police Station. Afterward, we will stroll along Hollywood Road where historical buildings and specialty stores stand. Next, we will visit PMQ, delving into the vibrant development of the creative industry in Hong Kong. Finally, we will visit the revitalised "30 Houses" and murals in Tai Ping Shan Street and experience Hong Kong's artistic vitality.





土瓜灣 To Kwa Wan

這個行程將會探索土瓜灣的歷史文化與藝術元素。首先行逛宋皇臺花園,了解南宋末代兩位皇帝的南逃流亡故事,然後漫步北帝街和「十三街」,歷史悠久的建築群展現土瓜灣的傳統社區風貌。隨後造訪此次遊歷的重點:建於 1908 年由屠宰場改建的牛棚藝術村,參觀 1a space 等藝術場所。這條路線讓大家了解土瓜灣的歷史變遷,體驗香港小劇場及實驗藝術的發展,感受藝術為舊區注入的新活力。

This route will be an exploration of the historical, cultural, and artistic elements of To Kwa Wan. First, we will visit the Sung Wong Toi Garden and learn about the history of the exile of the last two emperors of Southern Song dynasty. Then, we will stroll through Pak Tai Street and "13 Streets" to get a taste of the local community atmosphere of To Kwa Wan. Next is the highlight of the route, the Cattle Depot Artist Village, which was originally a slaughterhouse built in 1908, is now inhabiting art venues such as 1a space where arts energise the old district. This route will lead you to understanding the historical changes of To Kwa Wan and the development of alternative theatre and experimental art in Hong Kong.
